

Proposals regarding Rulebook changes for ISRA Delegates meeting 2007

The proposals presented below will all be discussed and/or decided upon on at the two meetings in Revuca, Slovakia. The first meeting is held on Sunday October 7 and the second meeting on the following Saturday October 13. Each meeting has some necessary questions to be attended to, thus are those listed below.

Proposal and suggestions can be submitted in advance to the ISRA Chairman or presented at the ISRA-meeting at b/. Questions raised in b and c/ shall be decided during a Delegates meeting held at the end of the event (Saturday).

First meeting - Preparatory meeting

At the ISRA World Championships a preparatory ISRA delegates meeting shall be held in the evening on the open practice day (Sunday). During the meeting shall the following issues be decided or presented:

- a/ The election of a Race Jury for the event according to section 1.2 of the rulebook. (2 officials and 2 deputies)
- b/ Choice of Delegates to fulfill Technical inspection duties during the week. (4 for each class)
- c/ Proposals for changes to the ISRA rulebook for the following years event.
- d/ Proposals of coming events. Finland and USA for 2009, proposals for 2010 --
- e/ Other questions to be considered by the delegates.

Second meeting - Delegates meeting

At the Delegates meeting the following issues will be decided upon:

- f/ Election of officials; ISRA chairman, ISRA secretary or ISRA technical officer.
- g/ Evaluation
- h/ Coming events. UK 2008 will inform, and a back-up nation chosen. Finland and USA for 2009.
- i/ Changes to the ISRA rulebook for the following years event.
- j/ Other questions.

Submitted proposals

Procedural questions

Elections of officials

This year it is officially the Chairman that is up for election/re-election. No proposals apart from re-election have arrived.

* An election committee must be re-instated and present their proposal for a new official the latest 30 days prior to the Delegates meeting. Proposals from individual licensed drivers can be submitted directly to ISRA within the same time frame. A proposed person must know they are and also have accepted to take on the duty.

Entry levels

- *
 1. Each country has quota according to ranking (first 70 places). Nomination of this quotas belong to country and application for the Worlds will be made by the delegate of the country.
 2. Any country of the World has 2 places guarantee.
 3. Home country has tripple quota from its ranking quota but maximal 15 places.
 4. 3 wild cards for Worlds organizer.

Time plans

A discussion is needed to instruct future organisers of what to do if time constraints develop.

- * A committee is elected to assemble ideas and to propose a set of guidelines by the latest New Year 2007. The proposal will then be decided upon in an e-mail vote among the Delegates. Sent in ideas up to this event will be forwarded to this committee.
- * Withdrawal or strict limitations (only the class that is going to be driven next day in the morning) of the 24 hour practicing rule.
- * Open practice on Friday prior to event.

Track conditions

- * A very clearly stated mixture of glue to be sprayed on the track, as well as restricted structure of how and when it is done.

Technical

Body rules

- * Bodies for all classes are decided by the event organiser.
- * A committee of three people develop new measurements for the Eurosport 24 and Eurosport 32 to take effect from new year 2007. The first body to follow the rules will then be ES 24.

Production chassis

- * 8.2 Production chassis
ISRA approves chassis for one class; Production 1/24. The **chassis** are approved on a technical basis of a **3**-piece stamped steel construction of a maximum length of **126** mm measured from the centre of the real axle and the centre of the guide pivot hole.
- * Chassis from Pro-Slot (2-piece) and from JK (3-piece) submitted.
